

APPENDIX

THE A.P. TRADE UNION REGULATIONS, 1927 (As Adapted by the State of Andhra Pradesh)

1. (1) These regulations may be called the Andhra Pradesh Trade Union Regulations, 1927.

(2) They shall extend to and be in force in the whole of the State of Andhra Pradesh and the territories in the First Schedule to the Andhra Pradesh and Madras (Alteration of Boundaries) Act, 1959 (Central Act 56 of 1959).

2. In these regulations,--

(a) "The Act" means the Trade Unions Act, 1926.

(b) "Form" means a form appended to these regulations.

(c) "Government" means the [Government of Andhra Pradesh].

(d) "Section" means a section of the Act.

'[(e) Words and expressions used but not defined in these regulations shall have the meanings respectively assigned to them in the Act.]

3. Every application for registration of a trade union under Section 4 shall be made in Form A.

¹[3-A. Upon an application under Regulation 3 being made, the Registrar may require from the applicants such evidence as may appear to him necessary for the purpose of ascertaining whether the applicants have been duly authorised to make the application on behalf of the trade union.]

4. The register of trade unions referred to in Section 8 shall be maintained in Form B.

5. ³[(1)] The certificate of registration issued by the Registrar under Section 9 shall be in Form C.

³[(2) Upon an application for a copy of the certificate issued under Clause(1) being made, the Registrar may, after satisfying himself that the original certificate is lost, damaged or untraceable, issue a copy thereof marked 'duplicate' on payment of a fee of Rs.2.]

¹[6. Every application for cancellation or withdrawal of registration under Clause(a) of Section 10 shall be presented to the Registrar in Form CC. It shall be signed by the Secretary and seven more members of the trade union.]

7. There shall be appended to every such application a certificate issued by the members making it to the effect that the statement contained in the application is to the best of their knowledge and belief.

8. Upon an application for the cancellation or withdrawal of registration of a trade union being presented to him, the Registrar, if he has reasons to believe, that the applicants have not been duly²[authorised by a resolution of the general body meeting of the members of such union] to make the same may, for the purpose of ascertaining the fact require from the applications such evidence as may seem to him necessary and examine any office-bearer of such union.

9. The Registrar, shall, when he proposes to withdraw or cancel the certificate of registration of a trade union under Clause(b) of Section 10 cause to be served a notice in Form-D on the trade union through its Secretary in person or by registered post.

10. The certificate of registration issued to a trade union under Regulation 5 shall be surrendered by the Secretary of the union when the Registrar decides to withdraw or cancel such certificate under Clause(a) or Clause(b) of Section 10.

11. (1) The Registrar on receipt of a notice of transfer of the head office of a trade union from this State shall forward to the Registrar of the State to which the head office of the Trade Union has been transferred, a copy of all the entries contained in the register prescribed by Regulation 4 and a copy of the rules of the Union with all amendments thereto.

(2) The Registrar of the State to which the office of the Trade Union has been transferred may thereupon enter in his Register the particulars relating to the trade union and certify the fact of such registration on the certificate already issued under Regulation 5. The Secretary of the Union shall present the certificate to the Registrar for this purpose.

(3) The procedure prescribed in Clause(2) shall be followed also in respect of a trade union whose head office has been transferred to this State from another State:

Provided that, if the name of the trade union, the head office of which has been transferred to this State from another State is identical with that by which any other trade union in this State has been registered or, in opinion of the Registrar, so nearly resembles such name as to be likely to confuse the public or the member of either trade union whose head office has been transferred to the State from another State to change its name and may refuse to act under Clause(2) until such change has been made.

¹[11-A. Notice of any change in the address of the Head Office of a trade union shall be given to the Registrar in Form-DD within a fortnight of change.]

12. ²[(1) When a Registrar registers a change of name under sub-section(3) of Section 25, he shall certify under his signature at the foot of the certificate issued under Regulation 5 that the new name has been registered. The Secretary shall present the certificate to the Registrar for this purpose.

²[(2) Notice of any change in the name of trade union shall be sent to the Registrar in Form-DDD within the fortnight of such change.]

13. ³[(1)] Notice of every amalgamation of trade unions shall be sent to the Registrar in duplicate in Form-DDDD within a fortnight of such amalgamation:

Provided any change in the address of the head office of a trade union shall be passed by resolution at a general body meeting of the trade union.

³[(2) When the amalgamated trade union is registered under sub-section(4) of the said section, it shall be assigned a new number in the register in Form-B and the Registrar shall issue a new certificate in Form-C thereof. He shall also note the fact of amalgamation against the entries, if any relating to the trade unions so amalgamated in the register in Form-B].

¹[13-A. (1) Whenever any office-bearer or member of the Executive Committee is convicted by a Court in India of any offence involving moral turpitude and sentenced to imprisonment, the union shall give a notice in Form G to the Registrar of Trade Unions within 30 days of such conviction.

(2) The Union which fails to give such notice shall be liable for action under the provisions of the Act.]

14. The fee payable for the registration of a trade union shall be Rs.5.

15. (1) On receiving a copy of the alteration made in the rules of a trade union sent under sub-section(3) of Section 28, the Registrar, after satisfying himself that the alteration has been made in the manner laid down by the rules of the trade union and is not inconsistent with any of the provisions of the Act shall register the alteration in the register of trade union prescribed under Regulation 4 and deliver to the Secretary of such trade union a copy of the alteration with a certificate appended thereto to the effect that alteration has been duly registered by him.

(2) The fee payable for registration of alteration of rules shall be Re.1 for each set of alterations made simultaneously.

16. Any appeal under sub-section(1) of Section 11 of the Act shall be filed within ²[ninety days] of the date of the order against which the appeal is made.

17. ³[(1)] When a registered trade union is dissolved, notice of dissolution shall be sent to the Registrar in Form-DDDDD.

⁴[(2)]. Along with the notice for dissolution under sub-section(1) of Section 27 certificate issued under Regulation 5 shall be surrendered. When the Registrar registers the dissolution, he shall send an intimation of the fact of such registration under his signature to the Secretary of the trade union.

[(3)]. Where it is necessary for the Registrar, under sub-section(2) of Section 27, to distribute the funds of trade union which

has been dissolved, he shall divide the funds in proportion to the amounts contributed by the members on roll at the time of dissolution, by way of subscription to the several funds of the trade union during their membership. In the event of the death of a member of a trade union subsequent to the date of its dissolution but prior to the distribution of funds, the Registrar shall pay the sum payable to such member to his legal representative.

17-A. Forms B and D '[and the receipt of the notice in Form 'DD'] which are by these regulations required to be signed or initialled by the Registrar may be signed or initialled under his discretion, and on his behalf by any Gazetted Officer subordinate to him in writing for this purpose.

18. The annual return to be furnished under Section 28 shall be submitted in duplicate to the Registrar on or before the ²[30th day of April] in each year and shall be in Form E.

18-A. Every registered trade union shall maintain the following books and registers to facilitate the audit of its accounts:—

- (1) Register of membership and subscriptions in Form 'F' ;
- (2) Register of receipts and disbursements of the General Fund Accounts;
- (3) Minutes book to record the proceedings of all meetings;
- (4) Register of stock, tools and plant showing the furniture fittings and valuable documents relating to the immovable property of the union;
- (5) Machine numbered subscription receipt book;
- (6) Register of receipts and disbursements of the political fund if there is a political fund; and
- (7) A file of vouchers.

19. (1) The annual audit of the accounts of registered trade union shall be conducted—

- (a) by an auditor authorised to audit the accounts of companies under [sub-section(1) of Section 226 of the Companies Act, (Central Act 1 of 1956)];

(b) by the Examiner of Local Fund Accounts or by an auditor deputed by the Examiner of Local Fund Accounts; or

(c) by the Registrar of Co-operative Societies; or

[(d) by an auditor appointed to conduct the audit of the Co-operative Societies by the Government or the Registrar of Co-operative Societies or by any Co-operative Organisation recognised by the Government for this purpose; or]

(e) if the membership of the union did not at any time during the financial year exceed 2,500 by any person who, having held an appointment under the '[Government]' in any audit or accounts department, is in receipt of a pension of not less than Rs. 200 per mensem; or

(f) If the membership of the union did not at any time during the financial year exceed 750:—

(i) by any person who, having held an appointment under *[Government] in any audit or accounts department, is in receipt of a pension of not less than Rs. 75 per mensem; or

(ii) by any *[State] Co-operative Organisation recognised by the Government for this purpose; or

(g) if the membership of the union did not, at any time during the financial year exceed 250, by any two members of the union.

(2) Where the trade union is a federation of the unions and the unions affiliated to it any time during the financial year did not exceed 50, 15 or 5, respectively, the audit of the accounts of the federation may be conducted as if it were an union whose membership did not exceed 2,500, 750 or 250 respectively.

19-A. Notwithstanding anything contained in Regulation 19, any registered trade union may apply to the Registrar to arrange for the audit of the accounts of the union. On receipt of such application, the Registrar shall subject to any general or special order of the Government, arrange for an audit of the accounts. The cost of such audit arranged through the Registrar shall be borne by the Government. A copy of the report of such audit shall be sent by the

Registrar to the trade union concerned and copy filed in his office. [A copy of the report shall be furnished by the Registrar to any person on application made with Court-fee stamp of one rupee affixed to it and accompanied by a sufficient number of copy stamp papers each of the value of thirty-five *naya paise*.]

Provided that application is made after the expiration of twelve months from the date of the report, an additional searching fee of rupees two shall be charged.]

20. Notwithstanding anything contained in Regulation 19, no person who, at any time during the year, entrusted with any part of the funds or securities belonging to the trade union shall be eligible to audit the accounts of that union.

21. The auditor or auditors appointed in accordance with the regulations shall be given access to all the books of the trade union and shall verify the annual return with the accounts and vouchers relating thereto and shall thereafter sign the auditor's declaration appended to Form-E indicating separately on that form under his signature or their signatures a statement showing in what respect he or they find the return to be incorrect, unvouched or not in accordance with the Act.

The particulars given in this statement shall indicate:

- (a) every payment which appears to be unauthorised by the rules of the trade union or contrary to the provisions of the Act.
- (b) the amount of any deficiency or loss which appears to have been incurred by the negligence or misconduct of any person, and
- (c) the amount of any sum which ought to have been is not brought to account by any person.

22. The audit of the political fund of registered trade union shall be carried out along with the audit of the general account of the trade union and by the same auditor or auditors.

23. (1) The register of the trade unions maintained in accordance with regulation 4 shall be open to inspection by any person on payment of a fee of ²[fifty *naya paise*].

(2) Any documents in the possession of the Registrar received from a registered trade union may be inspected by any person on payment of a fee ¹[fifty naye paise] for each document inspected.

(3) Documents shall be open to inspection on all days on which the office of the Registrar is open and within such hours as may be fixed for this purpose by the Registrar.

²(4) The Registrar shall furnish a certified copy of any of the documents specified in Clause (12) to a registered trade union or a member thereof, on application made and on payment of copying fee of seventy five naye paise for the first two hundred words (or less) of such document and thirty-five naye paise for every additional hundred words or fractional part thereof:

Provided that if such application is made after the expiration of twelve months from the date of receipt of such document in the office of the Registrar, an additional searching fee of rupees two shall be charged.]

³[24. The fees paid to the Government under these regulations shall be credited into the Government Treasury to the head of account [XLII. Miscellaneous Social and Development Organisations-(a) Labour and Employment-I. Receipts of Labour Department.]

⁴[25. The Hyderabad Trade Union Regulations, 1956, are hereby repealed:

BIHAR & ORISSA TRADE UNIONS REGULATIONS, 1928

Notification No.2575-XL-19-Com. Dated 19.11.1928

1. These regulations may be called the Bihar and Orissa Trade Unions Regulations, 1928.

[1A. These regulations shall apply to all Unions whose objects are not confined to, and whose head office is situated in the State of Bihar].

2. In these regulations—

(a) "the Act" means the Indian Trade Unions Act, 1926.

(b) "Form" means a form appended to these regulations.

(c) "Section" means a section of the Act.

3. Every application of registration of a trade union shall be made in Form A.

4. The register of trade unions referred to in Section 8 shall be maintained in Form B.

5. The certificate of registration issued by the Registrar under Section 9 shall be in Form C.

6. (1) The Registrar on receiving an application for the withdrawal or cancellation of registration shall before granting the application, satisfy himself that the withdrawal or cancellation was approved by a general meeting of the trade union, or if it was not so approved that it has the approval of the majority of the members of the trade union. For the purpose he may call for such further particulars as he may deem necessary and may examine any officer of the union.

(2) The Registrar shall, before withdrawing or cancelling the certificate of registration of a trade union under clause (b) of Section 10, cause to be served a notice in Form D on the trade union through its Secretary in person or by registered post.

(3) The certificate of registration issued to a trade union under Regulation 5 shall be surrendered by the Secretary of the union when the Registrar withdraws or cancels such certificate under clause (a) or clause (b) of Section 10.
